Standard Excel Shortcut Keys

Useful when reviewing

Ctrl + [Selects Precedents
Ctrl +]	Selects Dependents
CTRL+\	Selects non-copied cells in row
CTRL + SHIFT + \	Selects non-copied cells down a column

General navigational rules


Arrow keys	move selection in direction of arrow
CTRL + arrow key	move to end of current range
Hold Shift while navigating	extends selection to cell described above
F5 + ENTER	Returns to previous selection
Smart Selection	
F5 then Alt+S	Goto Special (to select types of cells)
SHIFT + SPACEBAR	Selects entire row
CTRL + SPACEBAR	Selects entire column
CTRL + F	Find cells matching text, formula or format criteria (hint - click "Options")
Others	
CTRL+1	Displays the Format Cells dialog box
F4	Toggles absolute/relative references
Alt + Enter	New line of text in same cell

nXt Building Shortcut Keys

The following shortcut keys c	only work with a Numeritas model.
Ctrl+Shift+Alt =	Cycle through nXt number formats and apply to current selection
Ctrl+Shift+Alt -	Cycle through nXt Calc styles and apply to current selection

Ctrl+Shift+Alt]	Trace dependents on selected row(s) (staggered)
Ctrl+Shift+Alt	[Trace precedents on selected row(s) (staggered)
